Free and Reduced-Price Meals:

Spring Creek ISD offers free and reduced-price meals to those students of families who qualify. Attached to this sheet is the Application for Free and Reduced-Price School Meals. If you are earning at or below the current income eligibility guidelines, you are highly encouraged to complete and submit the application to us at Spring Creek ISD. We personally review your application to determine whether your child(ren) qualify for free or reduced-price school meals.

If you currently receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, all of your children who attend school automatically qualify for free meals. Participation in other federal assistance programs, including Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), also provides automatic eligibility.

If you are eligible for unemployment compensation, you might also be eligible for free or reducedprice school meals.

The information you provide on the application is HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL and will only be reviewed by authorized personnel. Your information will NOT be shared.

If you believe your child(ren) may qualify, please complete and return the application to Mandy Poer as soon as possible. It is recommended that you return your completed application before the start of the school year so that your child doesn't miss a day of his/her meal benefits should he/she qualify.
