Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan

Staff members of the Spring Creek ISD look forward to the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year. We know parents and students are as well. We all have experienced some rather trying times lately in regard to the COVID issue, and it will be good to continue a normal routine as far a school is concerned. The Spring Creek ISD *Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Service Plan* has been written to address guidelines to provide a positive learning experience for all concerned in the education of our students.

Maintaining Health and Safety

- District staff members will continue to routinely clean and disinfect facilities and buses.
- Proper handwashing/hand-sanitizing will be encouraged on a regular basis.
- The sharing of personal items and supplies will be discouraged.
- Face coverings will not be required for any student or staff member. Using masks will continue be an option for students, staff, and visitors.
- Student and staff wellness checks should be conducted at home on a daily basis prior to arrival to school.
- Staff and students must report to the district if they have been tested positive for the virus. Upon testing positive, they must remain off campus until they meet the criteria for re-entry as provided by their doctor or local health department.
- Appropriate accommodations will be provided for students with disabilities as identified in the student's individualized education plan.
- The school district will work closely with local providers to provide information about vaccination sites upon request. COVID-19 vaccinations will not be required of staff and students.
- The district will remain in communication with local and state officials regarding updates pertaining to COVID-19 as well as other health related occurrences. Any necessary changes to procedures regarding the health related occurrences will be communicated to parents and staff members.

Continuity of Services

The Spring Creek ISD will continue to take appropriate actions to ensure continuity of services to all students. These actions will focus on addressing student academic, emotional, social, and mental health needs. Plans to provide a continuity of services include:

- To provide instructional materials/resources and activities to meet the needs of students.
- To provide wellness support to students and professional development for staff members.
- To provide opportunities for accelerated learning during the school day.
- To provide tutoring opportunities to students in need of additional assistance.
- To provide technology-based intervention programs.
- To provide Response to Intervention (RTI) programs for students struggling academically.
